- 9. Write in brief on the character of Laura Wingfield in *The Glass Menagerie*.
- 10. Consider Robert Frost as the first modern American poet with reference to the poems you have read.
- Write a critical note on the significance of the title of Robert Frost's poem, "The Road Not Taken".
- 12. Write a critical appreciation of Walt Whitman's Poem, "O Captain! My Captain!"
